The Worship Arts Director will create a worship vision for multiple campuses that is compatible with and sensitive to the demographics of each site, while maintaining a sense of consistency with the overall worship culture of Crestwood Church. This role will direct others in the implementation of the vision at all satellite campuses and will actively lead all facets of worship arts at the main campus.

A viable candidate will orchestrate compelling worship experiences that utilize fresh but familiar modern musical styles creatively infused with a splash of timeless traditional musical elements. In addition, the Worship Arts Director will implement creativity and variety in worship, adding multisensory artistic and visual elements and planning stage design and lighting to effectively draw people to an unmistakable experience with God. The Worship Arts Director must be able to actively lead worship from the guitar or keys with an authenticity that inspires and connects with the congregation.

The ideal candidate will be adept at attracting, equipping, and coaching all worship arts volunteers, and will foster an atmosphere of continual improvement. In addition, he or she will demonstrate a vibrant relationship with Jesus that facilitates encouragement of spiritual growth in the worship arts volunteers.
